Practice Camera Assignment

For this you will need to get your assigned camera from the camera closet (back sure the battery is fully charged before you leave). You will also need an SD card for this assignment. The last thing you will need is a small object of some kind.

You are going to take 4 pictures today. The object of this assignment is to get you comfortable with your new camera as well as show you how to save your photos to the computer and upload them to the server for grading.

One of the objects of this project is to learn how to focus on an certain object in your picture. For the FIRST PHOTO, put your object on the ground and take a bird's eye view of the object.

For the SECOND PHOTO, put your object in a new location and take a worm's eye view of the object. Make sure that the object is in focus.

For the THIRD PHOTO, take the object to a new location and take a picture using the rule of thirds.

For the FOURTH PHOTO, have your partner take a pictur	e of you.

Create a PowerPoint for your first three pictures. Each photo should have its own slide as well as a typed explanation of the picture. You do not need a title page. When you are saving the PowerPoint save the file name as your name. I recommend saving the file to your flash drive (for now save the file to your desktop). Once you have the file saved, drag and drop the file into the folder titled "Practice Camera". This PowerPoint will be a daily grade.

Save the fourth photo to your desktop or the flash drive and change the file name to your name. The whole purpose of this is to see that you can change the file name and save pictures to the server. Before you save your picture to the server, be sure to change the file name to your name. Then drag and drop the picture into the folder titled "Practice Camera Selfie." You will get a 100 for a daily grade if the name on the picture matches the person in the picture and the picture is in focus.
